A Must Go Trip This Summer!

Sat. 13 Hong Kong - Qingdao

Depart Hong Kong by air

Arrive Qingdao

Met on arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Hotel: Century Mandarin Hotel Qingdao or another Four Star Hotel

In the afternoon an optional excursion (cost included) commences with a walk on the beautiful seafront. Continue to the Tsingtao Brewery where you'll learn the history of how beer was made in the late 19th and 20th century. Taste plentiful free sample beer and receive a free beer mug as the perfect souvenir of Qingdao.

In the evening head for Qingtao International Beer City for the festivities associated with Opening Day.

Transport is provided to the Qingdao International Beer City but return to your hotel is by taxi under own arrangements.

Sun. 14 Qingdao

This morning's optional excursion is also included in the cost of your package and is timed to allow you to sleep in after last night.

Visit the Badaguan Scenic Zone with more than 300 villas in exotic styles dotted throughout an area of lush vegetation. Because so many different architectural styles are represented, it's often referred to as a "World Architecture Museum". Continue to Xiaoyu Hill Park to enjoy panoramic views of the city. Visit Zhanqiao Pier Park constructed in 1891 and now serving as the iconic symbol of Qingdao. The Park was extended by the Germans, who occupied Qingdao from 1898 to 1914. The 440m Pier leads to the famous Huilian Pavilion, a double-eave, octagonal structure built in traditional Chinese style

in 1931. It is now the logo for Tsingtao Beer.

Afternoon at leisure to explore Qingdao, go to the beach, or to enjoy the festivities of the Beer Festival.

In the evening re-join the fun and games at Qingdao International Beer City.

Transport is provided to the Qingdao International Beer City but return to your hotel is by taxi under own arrangements.

Mon. 15 Qingdao - Hong Kong

Once again, this morning's optional excursion (cost included) is timed to allow you to sleep in after last night.

Visit the Governor's Mansion, the former residence of the German Governor of Qingdao. Enjoy a dumpling making lesson at a typical local dumpling shop. It's basic, yet comfortable, and you can cook and eat like a local. Continue to the Old Stone Man Beach, one of the best beaches within striking distance of the city. It's very clean, wide and long and offers the best surf available in Qingdao.

The rest of the day is at leisure to enjoy Qingdao and the festivities of the Beer Festival.

Transportation will be provided from the Qingdao International Beer City to the hotel.

Transfer to the airport.
